## CHAPTER VI

### THE LEGISLATURE

#### **Section 49 - Definitions 4 of 2001 13 of 2001**

49.—(1) For the purposes of this Constitution, unless otherwise provided, “Parliament” consists of the National Assembly and the President as Head of State.

**(2)** An “Act of Parliament” shall be a Bill which has—

- (a)** been laid before the National Assembly;
- (b)** been passed in the National Assembly by a simple majority or such other majority as is otherwise required by this Constitution in respect of any particular Bill; and
- (c)** been assented to by the President in accordance with this Chapter.

**(3)** “Chamber” means the Chamber of the National Assembly.
